

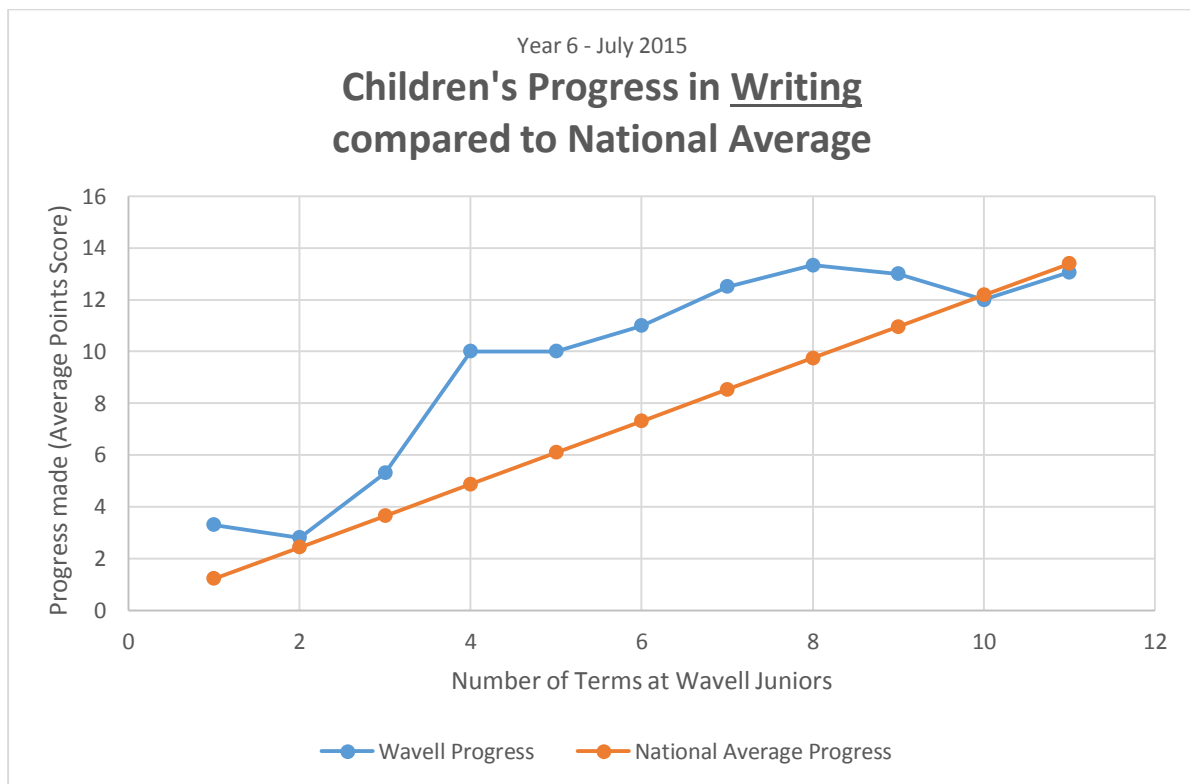
## How well do children learn while they are at Wavell Juniors?

The **3 graphs** below (scroll down to see the other two) show how much **progress** was made by children in Year 6 for Writing, Reading and Maths.

If you read across the bottom of each graph, the numbers show you how long different children had spent with us before they did their SATs exams in the summer. If you then move straight up, it shows you how much progress they made in that time, compared to children across the country.

For example, if you look across the bottom of the first graph for the number 4, you will see that children who spent 4 terms with us before they did their SATs made 10 points progress in Writing compared to an average of 4.8 points at other schools in the UK.

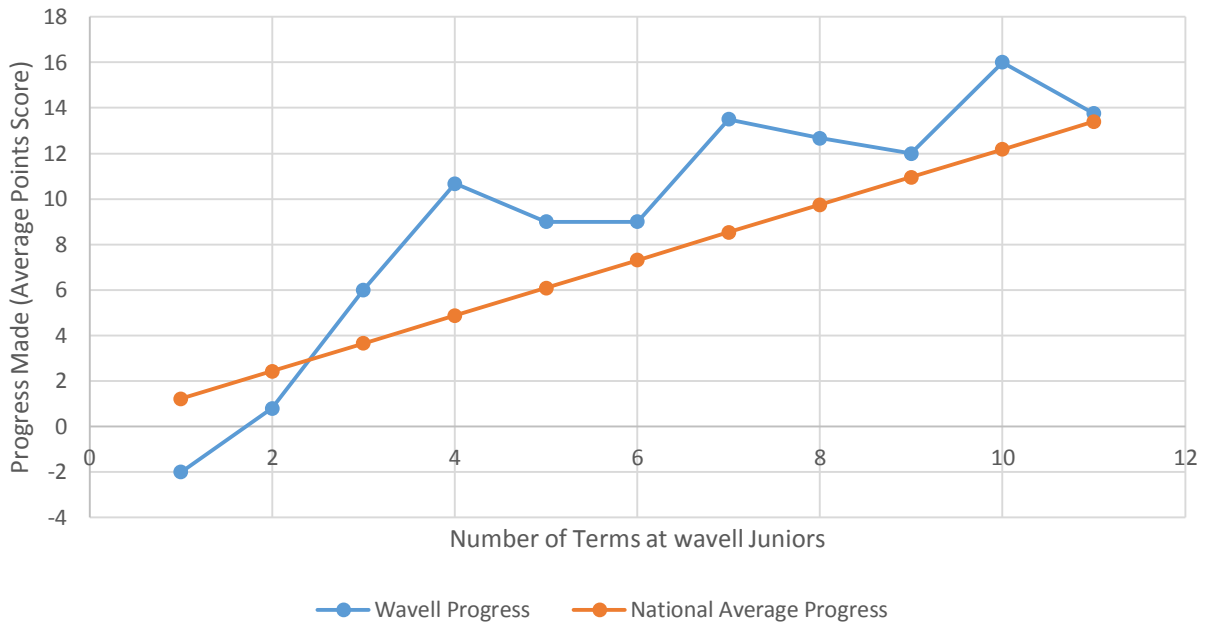
In almost all cases, the blue Wavell line is above the orange line. This shows that our children make better than average progress while they are with us.
